<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 2 whole-day English workshops cum immersion camp were held in mid-July.</li> <li>- The programme content included the learning of reseach skills and presentation skills. Apart from workshops held at school, students went on an outing to visit a location related to their choice of topic.</li> <li>- The program was conducted by native English teachers and featured excellent teacher-student ratio (1-4).</li> <li>- Altogether 21 highly motivated learners of English from S.4 and S.5 attended</li> <li>- Expenditure : \$17,700, paying service provider.</li> <li>- Balance: \$17,300</li> </ul>	<p>Students were highly satisfied with the programme.
